The Albany Township Board along with The Oak Township Board met on August 7 at 7:30 P.M. At Sandhill Circle, to discuss having the road tarred.

The plan is to repair the road this fall and have it ready for tar next year. Bidding for the project will be included in Stearns County's bid process. The township has the right to accept or approve the bids.

When completed 334 Street will have a 22 foot top and SandHill Circle will have a 20 foot top. It is planned to add a nine inch layer of gravel prior to construction. Included in the plans will be how the approaches to the residents driveways will be completed.

Borings will be completed on the road prior to construction.

Dave Gerads Construction will be doing the preparation construction on the road.

All information concerning the roads will be forwarded to the Township Clerk and disbursed to all board members.
